## Dudley's Egg Coloring Instructions

### Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper or freezer paper.
- Use the egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well, set aside to dry (Allow egg to completely dry before decorating).

### To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in each 1/2 cup of warm water and stir until dissolved. When you see what color is in each of the cups, set the pink coloring cup to the side (DON'T ADD ANY VINEGAR TO THE PINK ). For the other colors, add 3 tablespoons of vinegar.

### Helpful Dye Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar (tablet will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.

### EGG TATTOOS

- Remove the backing sheet and position the transfer on dry, colored eggs. Hold securely during the next step.
- Apply by rubbing firmly over the transfer with the enclosed applicator.
- Remove sheet carefully.
- Enjoy your cool tattoos

### EGG WRAPS

(ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED! - Hot water needed, for best results use large eggs.)

- Wrap eggs before coloring.
- Slip the Wrappits around a large hard boiled egg that has had time to cool.
- Submerge the egg into the hot water using wire egg dipper, metal tongs or a spoon. Allow the wrapped

## Easter Critters Instructions

Use the **Easter Critters** pictured on the other side of this sheet and on the packaging for examples and inspiration!

### **For Critter Feet:**

Find the pair of feet stickers for the critter that match the feet on the circular base stickers. Remove the sticker backing, and with the sticky sides facing each other, match up the toes and put the stickers together. Then place the egg on the sticky part of the circular sticker base.

### **For Attaching Bunny Ears and Chick Head "Feathers":**

Take one shorter ear sticker and a longer ear sticker, remove the sticker backing and with the sticky sides facing each other, match up the ears and put the stickers together. Place on top of the bunny's head, putting the longer tabs on the back of the bunny's head.

You can pull the stickers apart a little bit at the base where they attach to the head and push them down to adhere better. For the chick head "feathers", use the same attachment process as described for the bunny ears.

Add eyes, noses, whiskers, teeth, smiles and other stickers to make all kinds of great critters!

### **Foam • Gem • Alphabet Stickers:**

- Apply to dry, colored eggs.

### **Foil:**

- Wrap eggs in foil to create a golden effect!
