

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups or glasses with 1/2 cup warm water.

To Color Eggs:

- Place one tablet in 1/2 cup of warm water and add 3 tablespoons vinegar. Stir until dissolved. (For pink tablets use water only!)

Helpful Dye Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar (tablet will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Place egg in container until desired shade is obtained. For brighter color, leave egg in container longer. Use egg dipper to remove colored egg. Drain well, set aside to dry. Allow egg to completely dry before decorating.

To Create a Dapper Egg:

- Use stickers and googly eyes to create some dapper faces.
- Place eggs on egg stands. Add style by folding the egg stands on blue dotted lines.
- You will have the "BEST DRESSED" eggs this Easter!

See packaging for decorating ideas.

Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.

Condensation may cause colors to smear.

Caution: Children must be supervised.

Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.
