# EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS:

#### **Preparation:**

- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper. Wear an apron to protect clothing.
- Use bowl with at least 4 to 5 inch opening, that is deep enough to hold 1 to 1 1/2 cups of water that will completely cover an egg.
- · Bend the egg dipper handle to hold egg.

## To Color Eggs:

- Knead dye packet thoroughly. Open the dye packet along the dotted line. Completely pour one color packet into the bowl. The dye will dissolve, and the oil will float on the water. It is important to be able to swirl the egg through the oil. You'll need one bowl for each color.
- Place a dry, room temperature egg in the dipper loop.
   Slowly lower the egg, using a circular motion, through the oil and into the dye until the entire egg is submerged.
- Allow the egg to remain submerged for 1 to 2 minutes for red, purple, and blue and 3 to 4 minutes for orange, green and yellow.
- Remove the egg, allow it to dry, and then thoroughly wipe with a paper towel. Repeat the process for a multi-colored egg. Start with a light color and proceed to darker colors. For example: yellow to red, then red to blue.
- Add glitter with artist brush once dye is dried.

## See packaging for decorating ideas!

Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling. Condensation may cause colors to smear.

Caution: Children must be supervised.
This is a dye process. Colors may stain some fabrics.
