

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.

For Tablets:

- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

For Liquid Dye Packets:

- Knead each packet of liquid dye thoroughly.
- Cut each packet along dotted line to form the easy-pour spout.

To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved.
(For Pink and Purple tablets, use water only!)

Helpful Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes (NOT Pink and Purple - dye will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained.
- For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs:

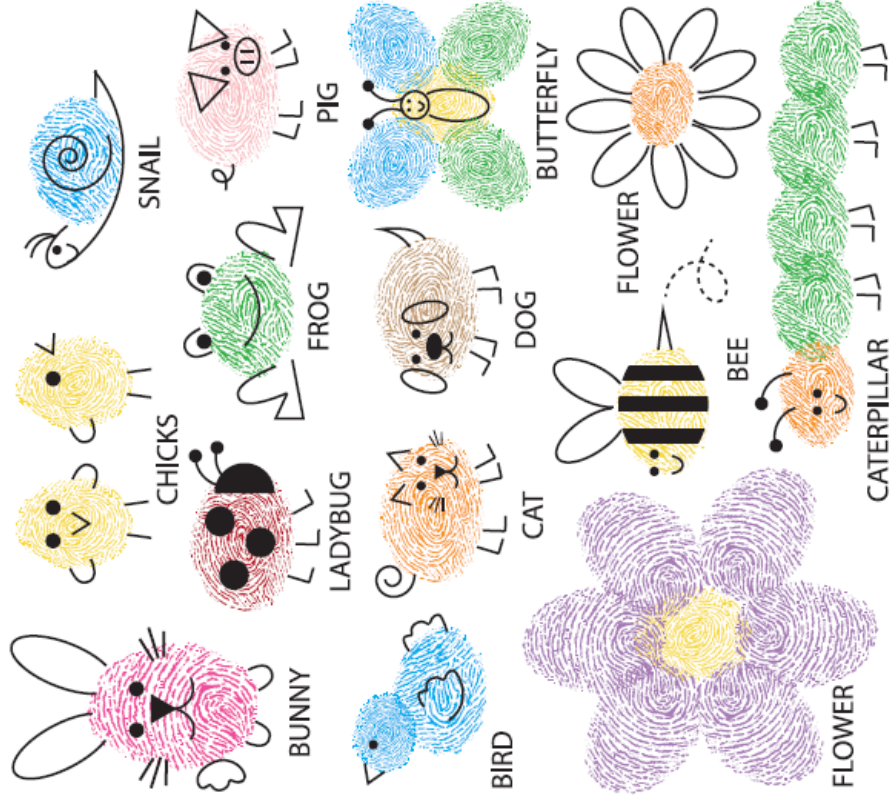
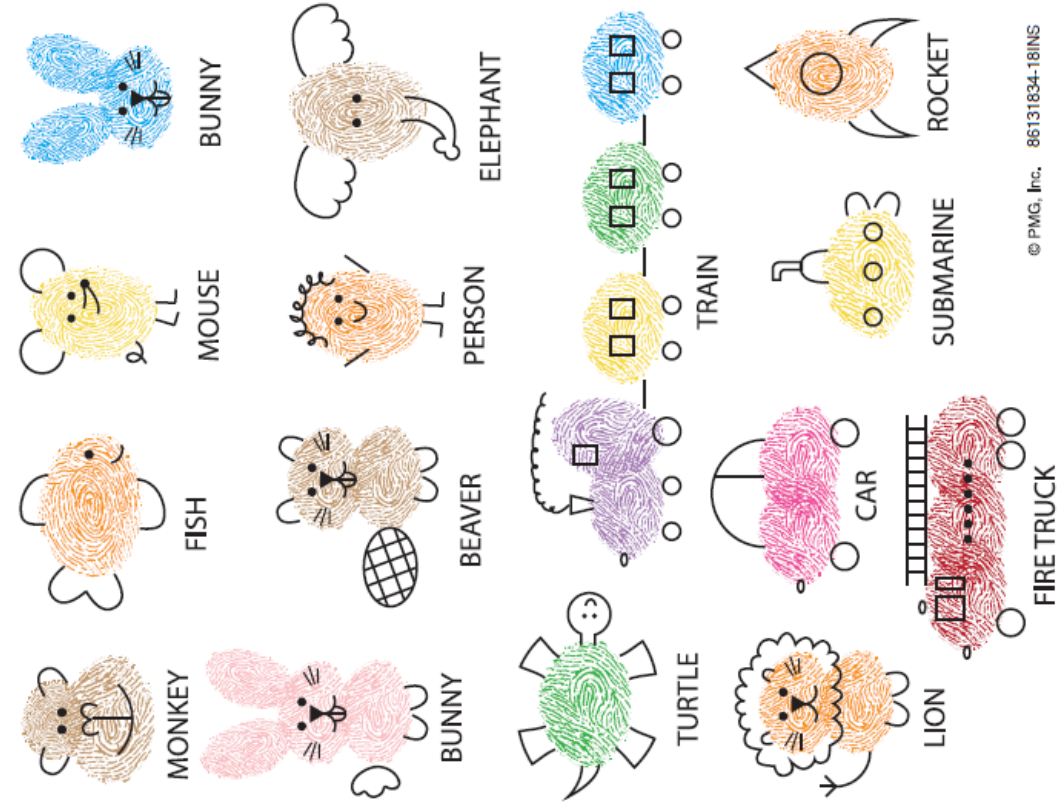
- Select desired design from instruction illustration or make your own!
- Dip your pointer finger or thumb into desired liquid dye color; dab off excess on paper towel (not included) for better design results.
- Gently press dye coated finger onto dry colored or white egg to create finger printing fun.
- Repeat steps 2 & 3 for characters requiring multiple fingerprints to complete.

See packaging for more decorating ideas.

Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.

Condensation may cause colors to smear.

Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.



To Decorate Eggs:

- Dip your pointer finger or thumb into desired liquid dye color; dab off excess on paper towel (not included) for better design results.
- Gently press dye coated finger onto dry colored or white egg to create finger printing fun.
- Repeat steps 2 & 3 for characters requiring multiple fingerprints to complete.
