EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

To Color Eggs:

 Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For Pink and Purple tablets, use water only!)

Helpful Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes (NOT Pink and Purple dye will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained.
- For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs:

- Select an egg stand to create eggs-pressions!
- Accent colored eggs with stickers to complete your characters!

Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling. Condensation may cause colors to smear.

Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.
