

## Dudley's Egg Coloring Instructions

### Preparation:

- Use cool, hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper, wax paper or freezer paper.
- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

### To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For Pink and Purple tablet, use water only!)

### HELPFUL DYE HINTS:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes (NOT Pink and Purple - dye will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained. For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

## Easter Critters Instructions

*Use stickers, pipe cleaners, and googly eyes!*

### Carrot:

- Use 2 pipe cleaners; twist together 1-2 times to attach; wrap 3 times around top of egg in a spiral motion creating smaller circles as you near the top of the egg; loop remaining pipe cleaner evenly 3 times to create carrot leaves; attach to egg using tape or glue (not included).

### Frog:

- Use 1 pipe cleaner; at the center of the pipe cleaner create 1" circular base; with the ends of each pipe cleaner create 2 loops at each end and twist 1 time to create the feet; arch each side of the remaining pipe cleaner to create frog legs.

### Pig:

- Use 2 pipe cleaners; twist together 1-2 times to attach; create 2 loops both 1" apart for front legs; twist 1-2 times; repeat for back legs; create circle base allowing 4 legs to stand; twist remaining pipe cleaner in a small spiral 2x to create pig tail.

### Bunny:

- Use 2 pipe cleaners; twist together to attach; wrap pipe cleaner around widest part of egg and twist to secure; create 2 even loops for bunny ears; twist ends for closure.

### Basket:

- Use 2 pipe cleaners; twist together 1-2 times to attach; wrap pipe cleaner around widest part of upright egg and twist to secure; create 2 even loops for the ribbon on top of the basket; leave ends to hang down on side of egg.

### Duck:

- Use 1 pipe cleaner; at the center of the pipe cleaner create 1" circular base; the remaining ends should create a V; loop the ends of each pipe cleaner and twist 1 time to create the duck feet.

### Butterfly:

- Use 2 pipe cleaners; use first pipe cleaner to wrap around widest part of upright egg twice and twist to secure; use second pipe cleaner to create 4 loops for wings; attach to first wrapped pipe cleaner.

**See packaging for more decorating ideas.**

**Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling. Condensation may cause colors to smear.**

**Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.**
