

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool, hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups or glasses with 1/2 cup warm water.

Egg Wrappits™: (ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED!)

For best results use hot water and large eggs.

- Slip the Egg Wrappits™ around a large hard-boiled egg that has had time to cool.
- Submerge the egg into the hot water using the wire egg dipper, metal tongs, or spoon. Allow the wrapped egg to cool before handling.
- Dye eggs after Wrappits™ are applied if desired.

To Color Eggs:

- Place one tablet in 1/2 cup of warm water and add 3 tablespoons vinegar. Stir until dissolved. (For pink and purple tablets use water only!)

Helpful Dye Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar. (Tablet will dissolve quicker.)
- Add remaining water to container.
- Place egg in container until desired shade is obtained. For brighter color, leave egg in container longer. Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well, set aside to dry. Allow egg to completely dry before decorating.

**Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.
Condensation may cause colors to smear.**

**Caution: Children must be supervised.
Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.**
