

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.

For Tablets:

- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

For Gold Glaze:

- Knead each packet of liquid dye thoroughly.
- Cut each packet along dotted line to form the easy-pour spout.

To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved.

Helpful Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes.
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained.
- For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs: (Adult Supervision Required)

- Use sponge to apply speckles of gold glaze to your robin's egg.
- To add feathers; hold feather in place and use sponge to lightly glaze over feather.
- Accent dry colored eggs on stands to showcase your nest of eggs.

Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.

Condensation may cause colors to smear.

Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.
