

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups or glasses with 1/2 cup warm water.

To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tablespoons vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For pink tablet use water only!)

Helpful Dye Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add Vinegar to dyes (NOT to the PINK – dye will dissolve quicker.)
- Add Remaining water to container.

Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained. For brighter color, leave egg in container longer. Use egg dipper to remove colored egg. Drain well, set aside to dry.

To Use Strings of Color

- Knead each packet of silver & gold glaze thoroughly.
- Cut each packet along dotted line to form the easy-pour spout.
- Use applicator to Strings of Color (puffy paint dye) over dry colored eggs.
- Wipe applicator with paper towel between colors.
- Place eggs on drying tray and allow eggs to dry before handling.
- Dry time may vary depending on amount of Stings of Color applied to egg.

- Caution: Children must be supervised since this is a dye process.

Colors may stain some fabrics.

- Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.

Condensation may cause colors to smear.
