

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For Pink and Purple tablets, use water only!)

Helpful Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes (NOT Pink and Purple - dye will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained.
- For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs:

- Cut glue packet along dotted line to form the easy-pour spout.
- Using a cotton swab or paintbrush (not included); apply glue to dry colored egg, ONLY to area colored sugar will be applied.
- Sprinkle desired amount of colored sugar to coat glue area. Create designs or coat your entire egg!

**Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.
Condensation may cause colors to smear.**

Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.
