

# EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

## **Preparation:**

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.

## **To Color Eggs:**

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tbsp. vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For Pink and Purple tablets, use water only!)

## **Helpful Hints:**

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add vinegar to dyes (NOT Pink and Purple - dye will dissolve quicker).
- Add remaining water to container.
- Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained.
- For brighter color, leave egg in container longer.
- Use egg dipper to remove colored egg.
- Drain well and set aside to dry.

## **To Decorate Eggs:**

- Using tape; tear off desired length of tape to design fun patterns.
- Accent dry colored eggs with stickers or personalize your egg creating letters with the tape.
- For two-toned eggs; apply tape pattern to egg and dip egg into one color. Allow time to dry. Add a second piece of tape to dry colored egg and dip into second desired color. Remove tape to reveal patterns.
- **Bonus:** Stickers can also be used as stencils; just apply stickers to dry white egg and dip into desired color. Allow time to dry and remove sticker to reveal additional designs.

**Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.  
Condensation may cause colors to smear.**

**Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.**
