

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups or glasses with 1/2 cup warm water.

To Color Eggs:

- Place 1 tablet in 1/2 cup warm water and add 3 tablespoons vinegar, stir until dissolved. (For pink tablet use water only!)

Helpful Dye Hints:

- Add 1 tbsp. of water to container. Drop tablet in water for color confirmation.
- Add Vinegar to dyes (NOT to the PINK – dye will dissolve quicker.)
- Add Remaining water to container.

Bend egg dipper and place egg in container until desired shade is obtained. For brighter color, leave egg in container longer. Use egg dipper to remove colored egg. Drain well, set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs:

- Decorate dry colored eggs with stickers and egg stands to create bunnies.
- Floral accents are connected at cut slot marks to create floral accent stand.
- See box for egg inspiration.

• CAUTION: Children must be supervised since this is a dye process. Colors may stain some fabrics.

- Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling. Condensation may cause colors to smear.
