

EGG DECORATING INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation:

- Use cool hard-boiled eggs.
- Cover work area with newspaper or waxed paper.
- Fill cups with 1/2 cup warm water.
- To create volcano stands; simply slot both halves of graphic into place.

To Color Eggs:

- Place damp room temperature egg into coloring pouch.
- Sprinkle approx. 1/4 of dye crystals packet onto egg.
- Gently rub outside of coloring pouch until egg is completely covered with color.
- Slide egg from pouch to 3-D volcano stand. Coloring pouches may be reused again.
- Using dropper; drip 1-2 drops of vinegar onto dye crystal covered egg to see fizzing effect.
- Remove from volcano stand and set aside to dry.

To Decorate Eggs:

- Accent dry colored eggs with stickers and stands for a more *eggs-plosive* effect!

**Allow refrigerated, colored eggs to dry before handling.
Condensation may cause colors to smear.**

Caution: Children must be supervised. Since this is a dye process, colors may stain some fabrics.
